

Constructed by aggregating selected Global Industry Classification Standard (GICS®) sub-industries, the MSCI Commodity Producers Indexes can serve as a broad equity proxy for global commodities. The MSCI Commodity Producers Indexes are part of the recently launched MSCI Thematic & Strategy Indexes.
