

The **MSCI Australian Shares Small Cap Index** is a free float-adjusted market capitalization index designed to reflect the performance of small cap companies in the domestic Australia equity market. The index aims to capture the small cap size segment of the investable Australian equity universe which represents approximately 14% of its free float market capitalization.



Index Methodology

The **MSCI Australian Shares Small Cap Index** includes index constituents that are similar to the MSCI Australia Small Cap Index constructed under the MSCI Global Investable Market Index Methodology, but it is free fl oat-weighted from the perspective of domestic Australian investors. The index is reviewed on a quarterly basis in February, May, August and November. Buffer rules are applied in the underlying index to maintain index stability and minimise turnover.
