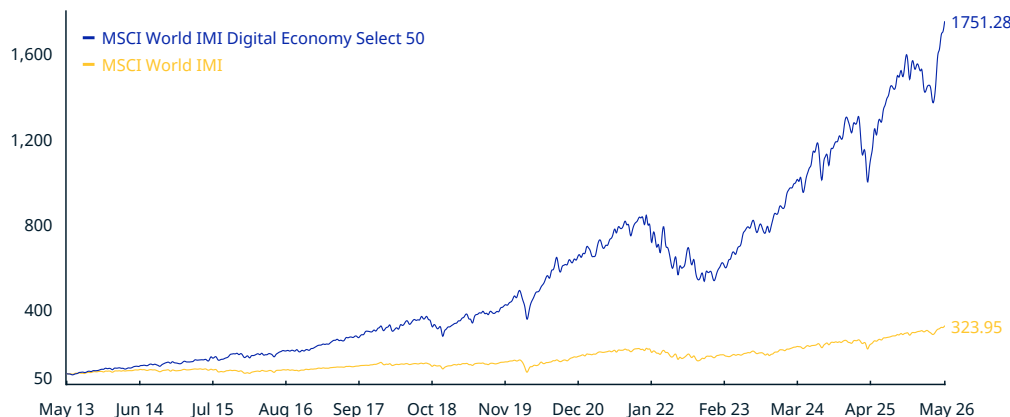


MSCI World IMI Digital Economy Select 50 Index (USD)

The MSCI World IMI Digital Economy Select 50 Index is based on the MSCI World IMI Index, its parent index, and includes large, mid and small-cap securities across 23 Developed Markets (DM) countries*. The index aims to represent the performance of the 50 largest companies that are expected to derive significant revenues from the digital economy value chain.

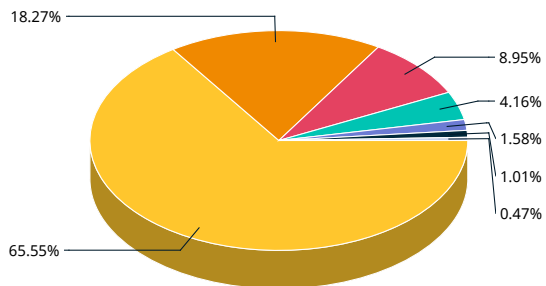

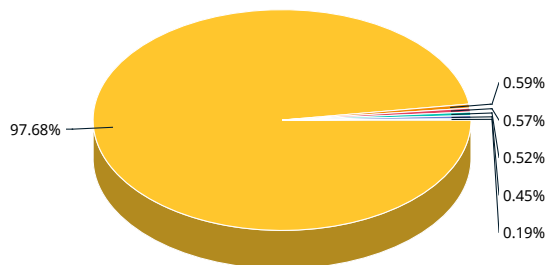
