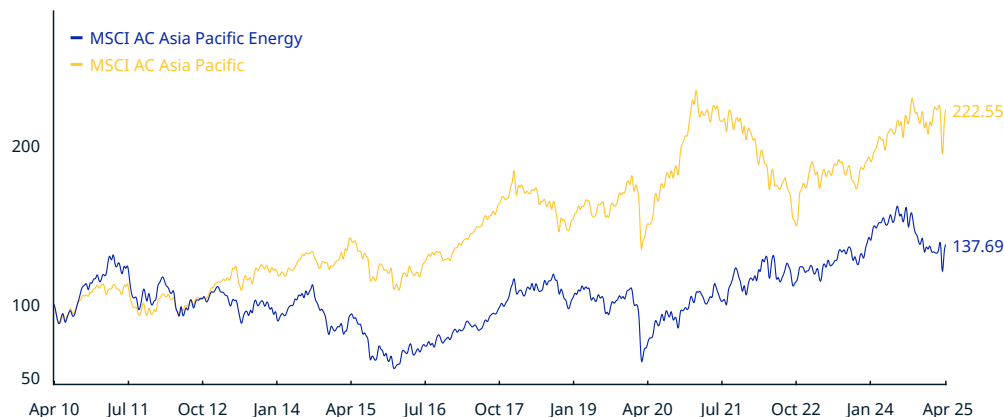


# MSCI AC Asia Pacific Energy Index (USD)

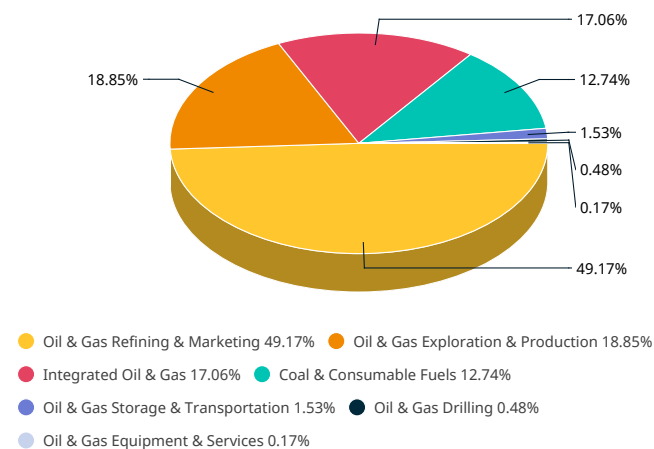

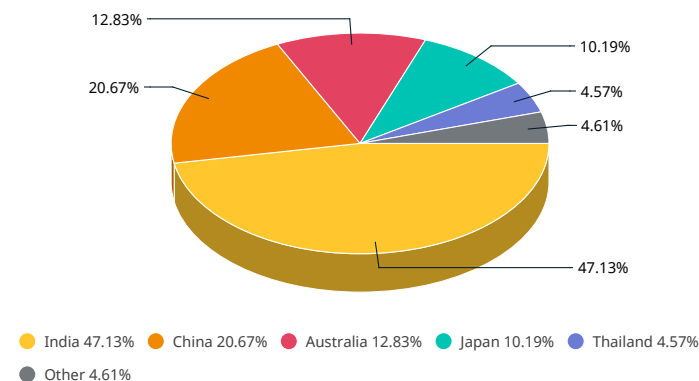
