The MSCI USA IMI and the MSCI EMU IMI are constructed based on the MSCI Global Investable Market Indexes methodology. The Industry Group and Industries classifications are defined using the Global Industry Classification Standard (GICS®), outlined in section 2. Securities from the same Region and GICS classification will in aggregate represent 25% of the index. Each security will have a maximum weight of 10% in the index.




