# MSCI Kukje (ACWI ex Korea) Index (USD)

The **MSCI Kukje Index** (the name used for the **MSCI ACWI ex Korea Index**) captures large and mid cap representation across 23 Developed Markets (DM) countries and 23 Emerging Markets (EM) countries (excluding South Korea)\*. With 2,477 constituents, the index covers approximately 85% of the global equity opportunity set outside South Korea.





These Factor Groups are constructed by aggregating 16 factors (e.g. Book-to-Price, Earnings/Dividend Yields, LT Reversal, Leverage, Earnings Variability/Quality, Beta) from the latest Barra global equity factor risk model, GEMLT, designed to make fund comparisons transparent and intuitive for use. The MSCI Factor Box, which is powered by MSCI FaCS, provides a visualization designed to easily compare absolute exposures of funds/indexes and their benchmarks along 6 Factor Groups that have historically demonstrated excess market returns over the long run.
