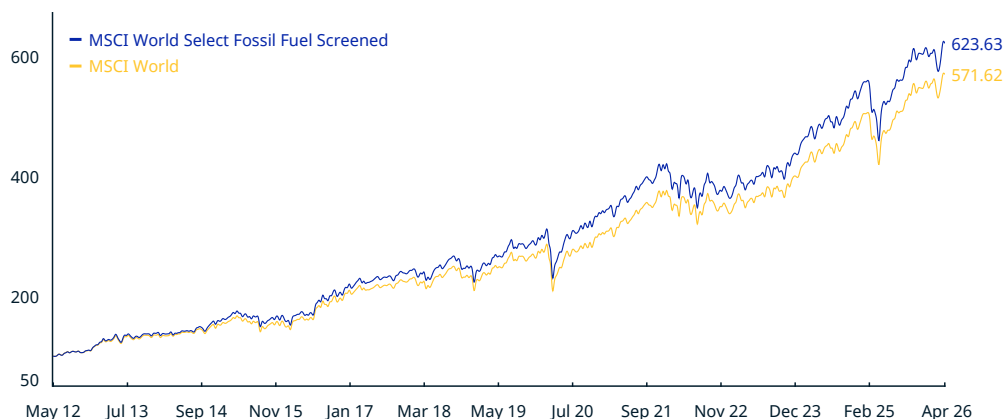


MSCI World Select Fossil Fuel Screened Index (GBP)

The MSCI World Select Fossil Fuel Screened Index is based on the MSCI World Index, its parent index, and includes large and mid-cap securities across 23 Developed Markets (DM)* countries. The index aims to represent the performance of a free float adjusted market capitalization weighted investment strategy that excludes companies from the MSCI World Index that fail to comply with the United Nations Global Compact principles or are associated with controversial weapons, nuclear weapons, civilian firearms, tobacco, thermal coal, oil sands, exploration and production of oil and gas or have evidence of owning fossil fuel reserves.

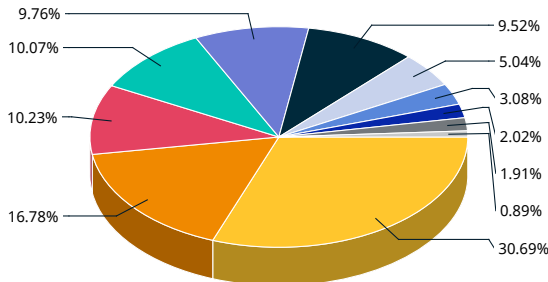

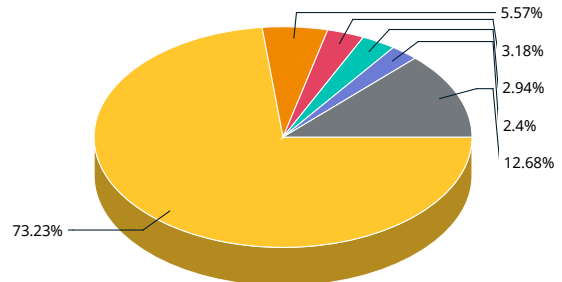
