
MSCI World ex Australia Small Cap Quality 150 Index (AUD)

The MSCI World ex Australia Small Cap Quality 150 Index is based on the MSCI World ex Australia Small Cap Index, its parent index which captures small cap companies in 22 Developed Markets (DM) Countries*. The MSCI World ex Australia Small Cap Quality 150 Index aims to capture the performance of a quality growth strategy by identifying the largest 150 stocks based on the free float market capitalization of the securities in the MSCI World ex Australia Small Cap Index, tilted by the Quality Score. The Quality Scores are based on three main fundamental variables: high return on equity (ROE), stable year-over-year earnings growth and low financial leverage.




