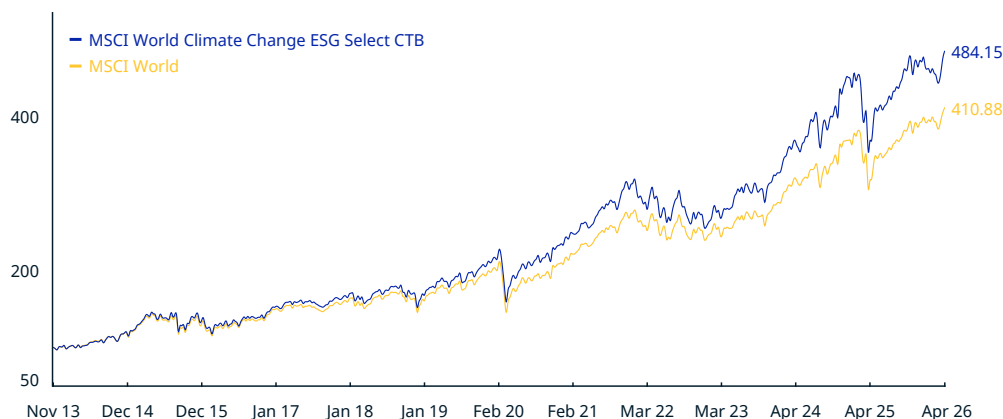


MSCI World Climate Change ESG Select CTB Index (EUR)

The MSCI World Climate Change ESG Select CTB Index is based on the MSCI World Index, its parent index, and includes large and mid-cap securities across 23 Developed Markets (DM)* countries. The index aims to incorporate additional business exclusion screens including Nuclear Weapons, Tobacco, Thermal Coal, Nuclear Power and Unconventional Oil & Gas. Additionally, companies that not in compliance with the United Nations Global Compact principles are also excluded from the index. Only companies rated BB and above are eligible for inclusion in the index. The index is finally diversified by capping issuers in the index at 10%.

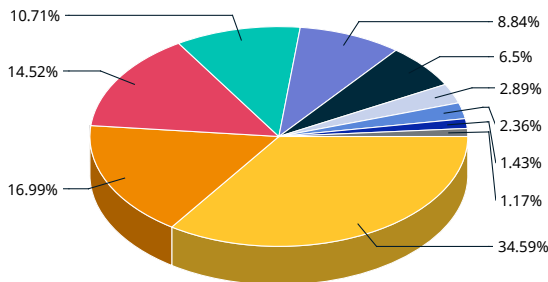

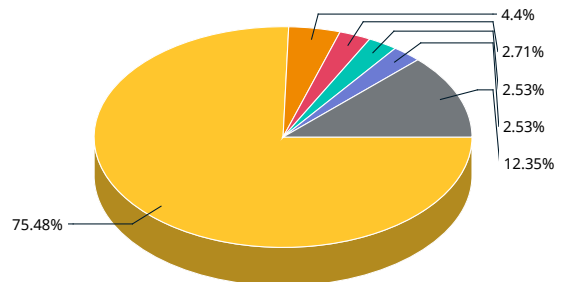
