The Index selects securities from the MSCI World Index which belong, each month, to the four highest ranked MSCI Thematic Indexes, as selected from a set of MSCI Thematic Indexes. The selection is based on theme specific media sentiment score (MediaStats Megatrend Scores) calculated for each of the respective themes by MKT MediaStats¹.




