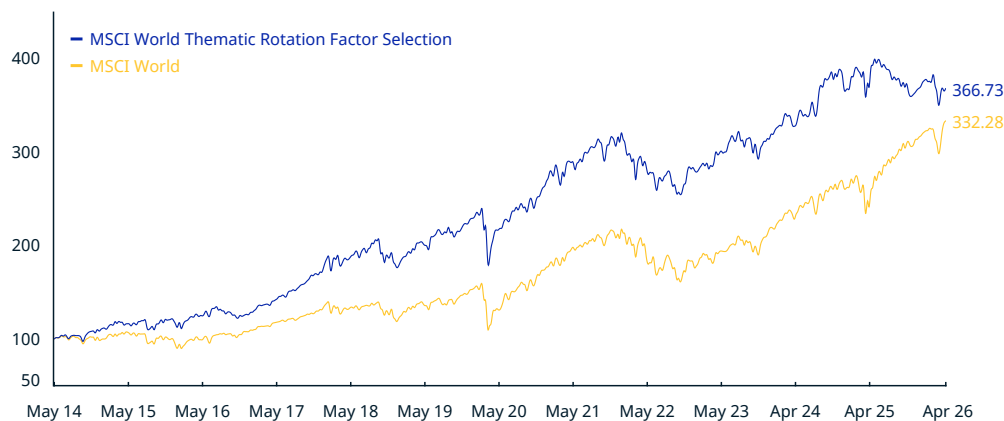


MSCI World Thematic Rotation Factor Selection Index (USD)

The MSCI World Thematic Rotation Factor Selection Index is designed to represent the performance of a strategy that seeks higher exposure to three style factors -Momentum, Growth and Quality - while seeking to minimize risk for a given set of constraints. The Index selects securities from the MSCI World Index which belong, each month, to the four highest ranked MSCI Thematic Indexes, as selected from a set of MSCI Thematic Indexes. The selection is based on theme specific media sentiment score (MediaStats Megatrend Scores) calculated for each of the respective themes by MKT MediaStats¹.

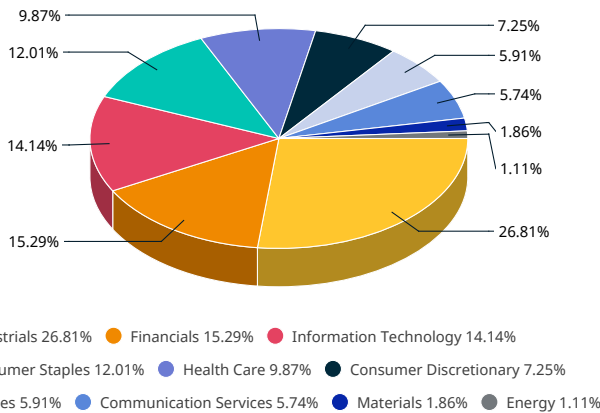

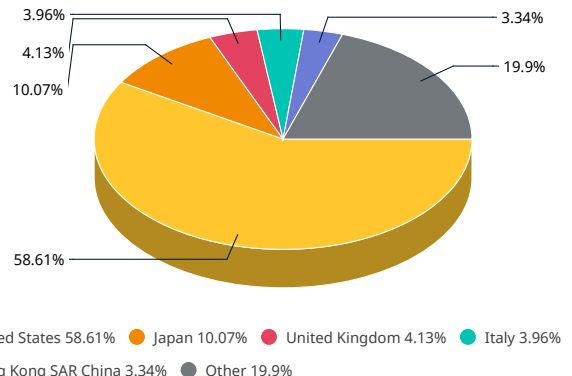
