The Index constituents are weighted according to their free float adjusted market capitalizations applicable to foreign investors. A selection of securities using ESG screens will be excluded from the constituent list of the Parent Index. All companies that produce and/or retail cannabis for recreational use are excluded from the index. The index further diversified by capping the maximum weight of any issuer in the MSCI World IMI Index at 10%.

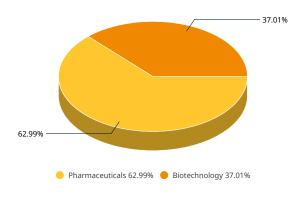

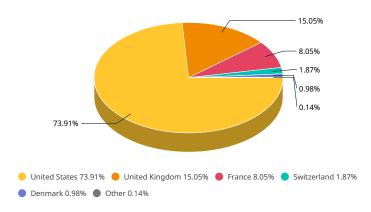
