

# MSCI World Dividend Growers Quality Select Index (EUR)

The MSCI World Dividend Growers Quality Select Index is based on the MSCI World Index, its parent index, and includes large and mid-cap securities across 23 Developed Markets (DM)\* countries. The index aims to represent the performance of 80 stocks that have consistently increased dividends historically and are expected to continue to increase dividends for subsequent one year based on analyst estimates as well as to continue to exhibit high dividend yield. The index aims to achieve diversification with country and sector constraints.

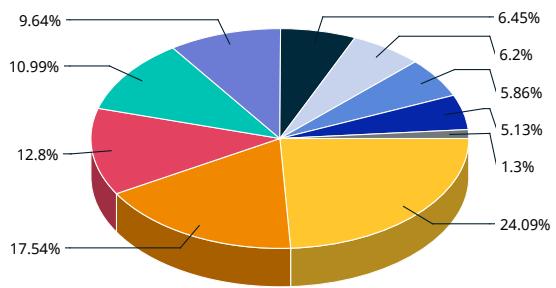

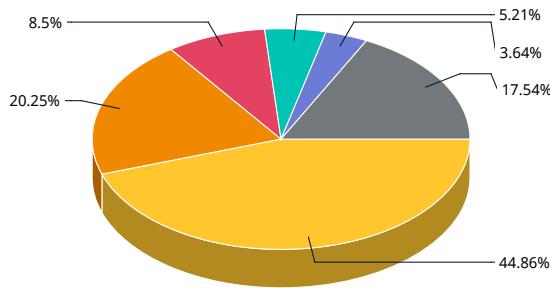
