MSCI ESG Ratings

MSCI ESG Ratings measures a company's resilience to long-term, industry-specific ESG risks using a rules-based methodology. Our team of over 600 analysts and data specialists, supported by AI, machine learning, and natural language processing, research and rate companies on a 'AAA' to 'CCC' scale based on their exposure to and management of these risks relative to peers.

MSCI ESG Controversies

MSCI ESG Controversies allows institutional investors to analyze a company's significant social, environmental, and governance impact by identifying company involvement in major controversies, adherence to international norms and principles, and assessing company performance with respect to these norms and principles.

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Sustainable Impact Metrics and SDG Alignment Tool

MSCI Sustainable Impact Metrics and SDG Alignment is a framework designed to help clients identify listed companies with revenue exposure to products and services addressing at least one of the world's social and environmental challenges, as defined by the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The product framework maps the 17 SDGs to five Actionable Impact Themes: basic needs, empowerment, climate change, natural capital and governance.

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EU Sustainable Finance Module

MSCI's EU Sustainable Finance Module, launched in February 2021, was one of the first solutions to take into consideration investors' SFDR needs. Our robust solutions are designed to save our clients significant time and resources and help them prepare for the upcoming disclosure deadlines. It includes both mandatory and optional Principal Adverse Impact indicators (PAIs) at the issuer and fund level as well as a self-service SFDR reporting solution called the PASI Statement.

MSCI's EU Sustainable Finance Module also includes the EU Taxonomy Dataset which is designed to help financial market participants identify and measure companies' involvement in taxonomy-aligned activities. To be taxonomy-aligned, an activity must contribute substantially to at least one of six environmental objectives, must do no significant harm to any of the other objectives, and must meet minimum social safeguards.

MSCI's EU Sustainable Finance solutions module also includes our MiFID II / IDD solutions which are designed to support financial market participants in aligning with their Markets in Financial Instruments Directive (MiFID II) or Insurance Distribution Directive (IDD) reporting requirements, as well as their needs to report using the European ESG Template (EET).

Research allows investors to identify companies
involved in activities such as the production of
controversial weapons, tobacco products, or
those that violate religious screening mandates
such as Catholic or Islamic Values. We cover a
large range of activities, including Abortion &
contraceptives, Adult entertainment, Alcohol,
Animal welfare, Biocides, Breastmilk substitutes,
Cannabis, Defense & weapons, For-profit
prisons, Fur, Gambling, Genetic engineering,
Nuclear power, Predatory lending, Stem cell
research, and Tobacco.
