The index is highly selective and has a global reach, with almost 50% of constituent company revenues coming from emerging markets and regions outside the US.

Concentrating exposure to 50 most actively traded securities can make it easier for investors to track and replicate the index in passive products

It can also serve as a benchmark for active portfolios, providing a concentrated, highly liquid exposure to the USA equity market.
