

Introduction to MSCI ONE.

February 3, 2023

Hi, my name is Whitney Rauschenbach, and I am the global head of ESG Issuer Relations at MSCI ESG Research.

I am happy to welcome you to MSCI ONE, a new platform designed to support the data visualize and interactivity needs of the issuers that we cover and other stakeholders.

We are excited to present you with this quick demo of the new platform features.

When you first log into MSCI ONE you will land on this homepage.

Note the navigation menu on the left and the “recent actions” which will help you to navigate to your frequently visited pages once you are active on the platform.

First, we will look at ESG for Company and Climate for Company.

We will then review the new Climate data verification feature located in Data Provisioning. Within Data Provisioning, you can also navigate to our ESG Issuer Communications Portal, or ICP, which will continue to serve as a key resource for you.

By selecting “ESG for Company” from the homepage, or navigating to the side panel, finding “ESG” and then selecting “Company,” you’ll be taken to your company’s ESG dashboard.

Here you’ll find an overview of your company’s ESG Rating, Material Key Issues based on our Materiality Map, information on ESG Controversies and Net Alignment to the UN Sustainable Development Goals.

Scroll down to see your ESG Rating History, Recent Developments affecting ESG Score, and Business Involvement Screens.

Next, by selecting “Climate for Company” from the homepage, you will land on the Climate Overview. This dashboard displays your company’s Implied Temperature Rise and details on the decarbonization target data that we have collected on your company.

The data supporting the ITR calculation is now available on MSCI ONE itself for data verification, feedback, and entry. Should you be interested in the underlying climate data we have on your company, or to enter a new target, we invite you to navigate to the Data Provisioning - > Climate tab.

Important to note, at the time of launch, Climate is the only data category that can be viewed and updated in MSCI ONE. All other data verification will continue to take place through the ICP.

Let’s navigate to the Climate tab under Data Provisioning to explore how to provide data feedback.

Here, you’ll see there are 4 dropdown accordions:

1. Targets
2. Performance

3. Mitigation
4. GHG Emissions

Each dropdown has the same functionality, so today we'll look at GHG Emissions. You'll find here the data we already have on this sample company.

We will review how to edit an existing record and create a new record to demonstrate the capabilities of the platform.

To read the definition of each indicator, click on the small "i". If you would like to provide feedback or provide an update to any of the data shown here, click on "Provide Feedback" pencil icon on the top right of your screen.

When you're in the process of submitting feedback to our analysts, I want to call your attention to the definitions on the screen.

The definitions of "update" and "correction" are the same that you might be familiar with in the ICP.

This will remain an important distinction, so please ensure you are comfortable with the characterizations.

To add a record, click the plus sign, new record. Enter the supporting URL (all data must be available in the public domain to be considered for evaluation), and all fields that have a red asterisk. You'll then want to Save the draft.

Make and save all of your updates before submitting. You'll see all saved updates under the relevant accordion. If the drafts were saved successfully, this will reflect on the page.

At this point, you have the option to invite colleagues to review the data. Upon login, they'll see the same "draft" information.

When you're ready to submit all your saved drafts to MSCI ESG Research for review, click "bulk submit" in the top right corner.

You will be prompted to acknowledge that you understand the MSCI ESG Research Corrections Policy – relevant if your submission includes any corrections.

Agreement of this policy is required to submit your data.

You should see a notice that the submission was successful.

If at any point you encounter an error message, whether with saving your draft or submitting your updates, revisit the submission to make sure you entered what was requested. Accidental characters or figures may also impact a successful action. If the issue persists, contact us at esgissuercomm@msci.com.

Now let's take a look at submission history, which includes the following information all in one place:

- Who submitted updates or corrections on behalf of your company
- Whether the submission was an update or a correction (the Issuer Classification)
- The value of the update or correction (Issuer Value)
- Where it is in the review process (Review Status)
- And whether or not feedback was accepted (and why)

You can filter by Issuer Classification, MSCI action, and dates.

Click "definitions" in the top right corner to see how MSCI ESG Research reviews and evaluates data feedback.

If you'd like to explore our library of issuer resources or provide feedback on other data categories, such as Governance data, navigate to ICP – the tab below Climate under Data Provisioning. Remember, ICP is still available for all data categories besides Climate.

We hope that this was a helpful guide. Thank you for continuing to provide your data feedback to us, and we look forward to bringing you new functionalities in the months ahead.
