


MSCI USD IG Climate Change Corporate Bond Index





Index Framework

The MSCI Fixed Income Climate Change Indexes are constructed in the following steps. First, the securities from issuers involved in controversial weapons business are excluded from the MSCI Corporate Bond Indexes (the 'Parent Index'). Second, a Climate re-weighting factor is defined that reflects an assessment of issuer's climate profile (based on the MSCI ESG Low Carbon Transition (LCT) metrics). Finally, the securities are re-weighted from the market value weights of the Parent Index using the combined score to construct the MSCI Fixed Income Climate Change Index. The Indexes are rebalanced on a monthly basis to coincide with the monthly index review of the MSCI Corporate Bond Indexes. The pro forma Indexes are in general announced three business days prior to the effective date of rebalancing.
