

1. Introduction

1.1 What Is IndexAI Insights?

IndexAI Insights is a conversational interface that lets you explore, analyze, and understand MSCI index data using natural language. Instead of navigating multiple datasets or tools, you can ask questions directly and receive answers grounded in your entitled MSCI content.

Whether you need a quick performance comparison, a constituent breakdown, or a methodology summary, IndexAI Insights brings the information to you in a single, coherent experience.

IndexAI Insights is available across multiple delivery channels at different release stages. See Section 3 for platform-specific availability and setup instructions.

1.2 Key Capabilities

IndexAI Insights brings together several layers of MSCI index information. The table below summarizes each capability area and the types of data you can access.

Capability	What You Can Access
Index Performance	Aggregate index data including index levels, returns across price, gross, and net variants, and fundamental ratios such as P/E (price-to-earnings), P/B (price-to-book), and dividend yield.
Constituents & Securities	Index composition data at the security level, including constituent weights, country and sector breakdowns, market capitalization, fundamentals, and valuation ratios.
Proprietary datasets and analytics	MSCI's proprietary datasets, including FaCS (Factor Classification Standard) scores measuring style factor exposures such as Value, Momentum, Quality, Size, Volatility, Yield, and Growth, as well as Sustainability and Climate metrics.
Corporate Actions	Events that affect securities and index membership, including dividends, splits, mergers, spin-offs, and rights issues, along with their impact on index additions, deletions, and weight changes.
Index Methodology	Rules and frameworks governing index construction, drawn from public MSCI methodology documents. This includes eligibility criteria, rebalancing details, and how derived indexes inherit rules from parent indexes.

Behind the scenes, a semantic layer connects related index concepts so you can ask follow-up questions naturally and receive contextually accurate answers.

1.3 Entitlements

The data you can access through IndexAI Insights matches your existing MSCI entitlements. If you need access to additional index modules or data sets, contact your MSCI account manager.

2. Use Cases & Example Workflows

The examples below illustrate how IndexAI Insights supports common client workflows. All responses are grounded in MSCI-sourced, entitlement-controlled content.

2.1 Insights & Analysis

IndexAI Insights supports iterative analysis: you can progressively refine your questions and build on prior responses within a single conversation.

Example workflow:

You Ask	IndexAI Insights Response
You: <i>Compare the performance of my custom MSCI World Core Multi Factor Index against the MSCI World Index.</i>	Returns a performance chart and comparison table, both downloadable as Excel files.
You: <i>Show me the top 10 constituents of the custom index.</i>	Displays constituent names, weights, and summary statistics.
You: <i>What are the P/E and P/B ratios for the largest holdings?</i>	Retrieves valuation metrics for the specified securities based on your entitlements.

2.2 Methodology Comparison

IndexAI Insights can produce structured, point-by-point comparisons drawn directly from public MSCI methodology documentation.

Example prompt: *"What are the methodology differences between MSCI ACWI Quality and MSCI ACWI Momentum?"*

IndexAI Insights will respond with a comparison covering:

- Factor definitions used by each index
- Security selection and eligibility criteria
- Rebalancing frequency
- Weighting approach

2.3 Content Creation & Communication

You can use IndexAI Insights to draft structured summaries and comparison narratives for internal discussions, presentations, or client communications.

Example prompt: "Create a one-page comparison of the MSCI World Index and the MSCI USA Index for an investment committee."

IndexAI Insights will produce a concise written summary highlighting key differences in coverage, composition, and performance characteristics. You can refine the output or export it for further use.

3. Accessing IndexAI Insights

IndexAI Insights is available in MSCI ONE, and can be connected to AI platforms, such as ChatGPT, Claude Desktop, or proprietary client systems.

3.1 Availability & Release Status

IndexAI Insights is available on the following platforms. Each platform is at a different release stage:


3.2.1 Prerequisites


3.2.2 How to Access

Once you open the interface, type your question in the chat box to begin your session. Results, charts, and data files can be downloaded directly from the interface.

3.3 Access via External AI Platforms

IndexAI Insights can be accessed through supported external AI platforms, allowing it to integrate into your existing workflows. The currently supported platforms are ChatGPT and Claude.

3.3.1 Important: Ensuring MSCI-Sourced Responses

When you use IndexAI Insights through an external AI tool, follow these guidelines to ensure that responses are sourced from MSCI data rather than from the AI model’s general training data or the open internet:

- **Enable only the MSCI connector:** Turn off web search and any other external data sources in the platform’s settings.
- **Verify the data source:** Each time the AI provides an answer, look for tool-call references such as "GetIndexGQLSchemaFragments," "Index_MCP link," or "MSCI API / MSCI schema." These confirm the response comes from MSCI.
- **Be cautious if no MSCI reference appears:** If the response does not show any MSCI tool-call reference, the information may come from the AI’s internal training data, the

open internet, or another non-MSCI source. In such cases, do not rely on the output as MSCI input. Do not rely on such output as MSCI input.


- **Ask the AI to confirm its source:** If you are unsure, you can ask the AI to confirm the source of the answer to verify that it is as MSCI-sourced information.

3.3.2 Access via ChatGPT

IndexAI Insights lets you query your entitled MSCI index data within ChatGPT through a secure connection to MSCI systems.



2. **Access tool through connector:** Open ChatGPT Web App application, select the MSCI connector in ChatGPT (Apps / MSCI connector). OpenAI does not yet support ChatGPT Desktop access to MCPs, so MSCI IndexAI Insights is not yet available through their desktop application.
3. **First time access:** At first time access enter the log in credentials to MSCI ONE (same as subscriber site login), accept terms of use and connection to MSCI ONE
4. **Start a new chat:** Start a new conversation, and attach the MSCI connector using the "+" icon. For best results, select the "Thinking" model. In the ChatGPT configuration panel, confirm that only the MSCI connection is enabled and that web browsing is disabled.
5. **Explore your data:** Enter your question and review the response. Look for MSCI tool-call indicators to confirm the data source (see Section 3.2.1).
6. **Continue, or start new:** Access your conversation history and resume previous session or start new.

3.3.3 Access via Claude

IndexAI Insights lets you query your entitled MSCI index data within Claude through a secure connection to MSCI systems.

4. Features & How to Use Them

This section describes the core features available in IndexAI Insights and provides guidance on how to use each one.

4.1 Downloading Data

You can download data files directly from any IndexAI Insights response: To trigger a download, simply include a download request in your prompt.

Example: *"Show me the year-to-date performance of the MSCI Emerging Markets Index and download data."*

IndexAI Insights will generate the analysis and include a downloadable file alongside the on-screen results. Supported download formats in MSCI ONE is csv which is convertible to excel.


4.2 Charting and Visualization

IndexAI Insights can generate interactive charts, performance plots, and visual comparisons to help you understand index behavior and trends.

Charts can be customized by:

- Time period (e.g., year-to-date, trailing 12 months, custom date range)
- Currency (e.g., USD, EUR, local currency)
- Comparison parameters (e.g., relative performance)

Example: "Plot performance comparison for MSCI World Core Multi Factor Index vs MSCI World Index."



4.3 Analysis & Insights

Ask conversational questions to receive performance comparisons, constituent breakdowns, valuation summaries, and factor exposure analysis. You can refine your questions iteratively within the same session.



4.4 Content/Blog Creation

IndexAI Insights can generate summaries suitable for presentations, or internal communications. You can request specific formats such as one-page summaries, comparison narratives, or briefing notes.

Example (below example uses Claude Desktop): *"Draft a one page comparison dashboard for MSCI USA Screened Index and MSCI USA Index for our quarterly review."*

The output can be refined through follow-up prompts and exported for further editing



5. Known Limitations

6. Future Enhancements

The following capabilities are planned for future releases of IndexAI Insights. Specific timelines will be communicated through your MSCI account manager.

- **Enhanced `Index Metrics`:** Richer analytics with multi-dimensional views of performance and exposures.
- **Custom Index Design & Simulation:** Natural-language prompts for exploring new index ideas and running scenario analyses.
- **Real-Time Alerts:** Stay ahead with notifications on key events, rebalancings, and significant index movements

7. Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What data can I access through IndexAI Insights?

You can access any MSCI index data covered by your existing entitlements, including performance metrics, constituents, factor analytics, corporate actions, and methodology documentation.

Q: Is the data real-time?

No. Index data is updated on a regular schedule, generally on a T+1 basis. IndexAI Insights does not provide intraday data.

Q: Can I use IndexAI Insights for indexes I do not have a license for?

No. IndexAI Insights respects your existing MSCI entitlements. If you attempt to query data outside your license, the tool will not return results. Contact your MSCI account manager to discuss expanding your coverage.

Q: My query timed out. What should I do?

Try simplifying your prompt or breaking it into smaller requests. For example, instead of comparing five indexes at once, start with two. If the issue persists, contact MSCI support.

Q: How do I know whether a response comes from MSCI data?

When using external AI platforms, check for MSCI tool-call references in the response (e.g., "GetIndexGQLSchemaFragments" or "MSCI API"). If no such reference appears, the response may not be sourced from MSCI. See Section 3.2.1 for details.





2. Scroll to the bottom and click Add custom connector.





Open Claude using the desktop application or access it via a web browser at <https://claude.ai/>. Log in with valid credentials if you are not already signed in. Upon successful login, the welcome screen will appear with navigation options on the left-hand side.




- **Step 2: Open Settings**

From the top menu, click on File and then select Settings to open the configuration panel.




