Understand Nature-Related Risks and Opportunities Across Portfolios



Nature-related risks are financially material; trillions in global corporate revenues depend on nature's services, from water availability to soil fertility and climate regulation. As biodiversity declines, companies face rising nature-related physical and transition risks, including stranded assets, supplychain disruptions, and price volatility.

The MSCI Nature Metrics – Issuer Level module helps investors identify, measure, and manage nature related physical and transition risks and opportunities at the company level and their capacity to mitigate or adapt through policies, programs, and risk management processes.

It assesses issuers' negative impacts on nature (e.g., land use, water use, GHG emissions, and pollution). And it also highlights nature-positive opportunities, such as revenue from sustainable products or nature-based solutions.

Incorporating data such as the WWF Biodiversity Risk Filter, MSCI's framework is designed to align with the TNFD's LEAP approach, supporting screening, risk quantification, and disclosure.

Together, these metrics enable investors and banks to translate nature and biodiversity risks into financial insights, helping them protect long-term value while aligning portfolios with emerging regulations and global sustainability goals.
