

The Rise of Women on Boards


The number of women on corporate boards increases yearly, but the growth rate slowed in 2020 following Methodology: a moderate uptick in 2019. MSCI ESG Research observed a 0.6% growth rate among MSCI ACWI Index companies in 2020, and outlined three projection scenarios for the decades ahead. ↓

Results collected by MSCI ESG Research LLC on the gender diversity at the corporate boards of MSCI ACWI Index constituents as of Oct. 30, 2020.


 Progressive Scenario Increased growth rate ② Business-as-usual Scenario Stable growth rate
