1 Introduction

The MSCI World Health Care 4% Decrement Index, MSCI World Information Technology 4% Decrement Index, (herein, "MSCI World Sector 4% Decrement Indexes") are constructed by applying the MSCI Global Investable Market Indexes Methodology¹. All securities in the index are classified as per the Global Industry Classification Standard (GICS®). A constant markdown ('synthetic dividend') is subsequently applied on a daily basis, expressed as a percentage of performance.

2 Constructing the MSCI World Sector 4% Decrement Indexes

2.1 ELIGIBLE UNIVERSE

The eligible universe for MSCI World Sector 4% Indexes includes all the constituents of their respective MSCI parent index (the "Parent Index"), as shown in the table below:

2.2 APPLYING THE MSCI DECREMENT INDEXES METHODOLOGY

A constant markdown ('synthetic dividend') is applied on the Parent Index levels on a daily basis, expressed as a percentage of performance, to construct the MSCI World Sector 4% Indexes using the following parameters.
